**FINAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT IN FAVOR OF DEFENDANTS,

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for hearing on November 5, 2013, upon the Motion of TEHC, LLC and Community Services Council of Brevard, Inc. for Final Summary Judgment (the "Motion"). The Court, having reviewed the Motion, the submissions of the parties and applicable case law, having heard the arguments of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Motion of TEHC, LLC and Community Services Council of Brevard, Inc. for Final Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**.

2. Final Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Defendant, TEHC, LLC, whose address is 8525 NW 53rd Terrace, Suite 200, Miami, Florida 33166, and against Plaintiffs, Trofemina Zampano and Joseph Zampano, whose address is 515 Margaret St., Merritt Island, Florida 32953, on Counts V (negligent hiring as to TEHC) and VI (respondeat superior as to TEHC) of Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint.

3. Final Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Community Services Council of Brevard, Inc., whose address is 3600 W. King St., Suite 1, Cocoa, Florida 32926, and against Plaintiffs, Trofemina Zampano and Joseph Zampano, whose address is 515 Margaret St., Merritt

Island, Florida 32953, on Counts VII (negligent hiring as to Aging Matters) and IX (respondeat superior as to Aging Matters) of Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint.

4. Plaintiffs, Trofemina Zampano and Joseph Zampano, shall take nothing by this action from Defendants, TEHC, LLC and Community Services Council of Brevard, Inc., and said Defendants shall go hence without day.

5. The Court expressly reserves jurisdiction to ^{*award*} award attorneys' fees and costs in accordance with applicable law.
